



Appendix 1 To All Clubs:

PERFORMANCE QUALITY STANDARD (PQS) OUTFIELD ASSESSMENT PROJECT

Nick James (Cheshire and ECB Grounds Adviser) has secured part funding from the Cheshire Cricket Board towards Outfield Advice for Clubs. Three CCCL clubs took part in a pilot and the scheme is open to other Cheshire Clubs.

There is a part payment of £100 by the Club.

A full inspection of the outfield together with analysis of samples is taken and a full report on the condition of the outfield and a work programme is provided. This includes fertiliser, seed, machine operations such as vertidraining, scarifyying etc and follow up advice.

If you remember we ran a similar scheme for pitches a few years ago which Clubs took advantage of..
