## Section One Rule Amendments:

**“Proposed change number 1 – Increase the number of allowed overseas amateurs to two rather than one.**

Rule 9 (b) (i) :

(i) All clubs will be allowed to register one **(two)** overseas amateur player(s) (i.e. an individual who is not normally resident in the United Kingdom).

(ii) The overseas amateur player(s) must be resident in the United Kingdom from Apr 1st onwards preceding the season.

(iii) It shall be the duty of all member clubs to ensure that the requirements of the relevant Government Immigration Department(s) are complied with. If they are not, any such player(s) shall be deemed ineligible for registration.

(iv) The League Management Committee will have the final decision re-registration of overseas players and therefore any Club wishing to register an overseas amateur, must supply to the The League Management Committee before 20th March each year details of the overseas amateur(s) they wish to register. Such details to include name, copy passport, reason for trip to UK, details of past playing standard and current club in place of birth/residence.

(v) Any applications to the League Management Committee after 20th March, should be submitted in writing, with the prescribed deposit, to the League Secretary for adjudication.

(vi) For the purpose of this rule, any foreign national who is a permanent resident in the United Kingdom, will be deemed a United Kingdom national

8 clubs were in favour, this rule shall remain as is for 2019

**Proposed change number 2 – Remove the requirement for an overseas to be resident in the UK from April 1<sup>st</sup> onwards but ensure an application has been sent to the league prior to the start of the season.**

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(v) Any applications to the League Management Committee after 20th March, should be submitted in writing, with the prescribed deposit, to the League Secretary for adjudication. **The final application deadline for an overseas amateur is prior to the first match of the season.**
