



Present & Apologies



Correspondence

- <u>Request from Woodley CC to play their under 11 matches on an AstroTurf wicket on the square,</u> <u>following successful trial last season</u> This was agreed as acceptable. Woodley must inform their opposition well in advance to make sure they don't bring spikes, and bails should be in pace with an understanding that if the ball hits the stumps the batsman is out.
- <u>Bill Higginbottom querying start of the season</u>. This was a point for discussion but discussed now following as email from Hayfield, the following was decided: Following so much heavy and continuing rain (not to mention all that snow) the League has decided to postpone the start of the season. First league games will be 28th April with those due to be played 21st April moved to 2nd September. The two under 17 games scheduled for 23rd and 26th April have been moved to 30th July and
